Under the supervision of the Manager of Clinical and Nursing Services, the Clinical Community Nurse— HCC nurse plays a crucial role in providing consultations to community members at home and/or at the clinic. Take responsibility for a range of nursing care based on the biopsychosocial needs of the patients. This includes health assessments, delivering initial care, determining, and implementing nursing care and treatments, including prescriptions, all while respecting Indigenous culture.

With expertise, ensure patient follow-up and collaborate with other healthcare professionals. In addition to clinical responsibilities, he/she contributes to the development or adaptation of clinical tools. Administrative tasks related to the smooth operation of the health clinic are also under purview.

Collaborating with other healthcare professionals, implementing health promotion and disease prevention programs, and presenting them to patient groups or individuals considering their needs.
